



Schuylkill Snap! Photo Contest

Theme: Moments of Joy – Photos that freeze genuine happiness

Submission Guidelines:

- Any current Penn State Schuylkill student (full-time or part-time) may enter the contest.
- The photo should capture the essence of the theme.
- Digital photo entries must be submitted prior to midnight on February 27, 2026, at <https://bit.ly/SchuylkillSnapPhotoContest>
- Submissions are limited to two photos per PSU email address.
- Each participant is eligible to have only one image place in the contest. If multiple entries from the same person qualify for placement, only the highest-ranking image will be awarded.
- The photo must have been taken by the person submitting it.
- Using built-in filters and color adjustments is acceptable but altering photos by adding or removing objects/elements is prohibited.
- Images should be high quality. When in doubt, upload the largest version of the image as possible.
- By submitting an image, you attest to your ownership of the image and individuals who appear in your photo (if any) consent to their image being included in the contest. You also agree that Penn State University has the right and license to redistribute the image, royalty free, on its various communications platforms, including but not limited to Penn State Schuylkill News and various official social media platforms.
- Submissions that do not follow these guidelines will not be considered.

Exhibition Guidelines:

- The Art Space Steering Committee will choose 30 photos to be exhibited on campus beginning March 16, 2026.
- The selected photos will be produced as 11" x 14" prints and framed by the Art Space Steering Committee.
- Photos will be judged by three PSU approved judges. PSU Schuylkill Student Affairs has donated the awards – LionCash \$175. Top three will be awarded: First place \$100, Second place \$50, and Third place \$25.
- Winners will be announced at the art show opening reception March 19, 2026, at 5p in the Art Space in the Community Center.
