## KEYNOTE SPEAKER

**William J. Reppy, M.B.A.**

William Reppy serves as President of Lehigh Valley Hospital–Schuylkill and Vice President of Lehigh Valley Health Network’s Northwest Region (including Schuylkill, Luzerne, and Carbon counties). He also serves as the management representative to the Board of Managers of LVHN EMS, a wholly owned subsidiary of LVHN providing ambulance services in Lehigh, Monroe, and Luzerne counties.

Reppy began his tenure with LVHN at their Hazleton location in 2014, as the Vice President of Operations. In this role, Reppy was responsible for Clinical Support Departments, safety, security and plant operations, and played a vital role in strategic planning, business development, and physician recruitment. Prior to joining LVHN, he was part of the Greater Hazleton Health Alliance. For several years, Reppy served as the Schuylkill County Administrator, where he was responsible for day-to-day operations as well as development of a comprehensive Personnel Policy and Procedure Manual and significant reduction in longer term benefits liability.

Reppy received an Associate in Science degree in Radiologic Technology from George Washington University, a Bachelor of Business degree from St. Leo University, and a Master of Business Administration degree from Kutztown University.

Reppy served in uniform for six years in the U.S. Navy as an X-ray technologist, is active in the Orwigsburg Lions Club and other community service organizations, and serves as a member of 13 local non-profit boards, including Nativity BVM High School, the Pottsville City Health Board, and the Penn State Schuylkill Advisory Board.
