How it works

Penn State Schuylkill's Dual Enrollment Majors are open to high school seniors and run the duration of the school year.

Beginning in the fall, participants spend part of their regular school day at Penn State Schuylkill, taking classes and attending enrichment programming such as guest expert lectures, company tours, and job shadowing. Upon completing their Penn State classes for the day, students return to their respective schools for regular coursework. Students provide their own transportation to and from Penn State Schuylkill.

Earn college credit at a discount

Students who participate in a Dual Enrollment Major are officially enrolled at Penn State Schuylkill and receive a 50 percent tuition reduction. Participating students will enroll in one Penn State class per semester, earning six to eight Penn State credits upon completion of the year-long program.

On the fast track to a degree

Courses students take as part of the Dual Enrollment Major correlate to specific Penn State degree programs, allowing students to get a head start on their college education.

Test drive a college major during your senior year of high school
